

# Regulations for the Implementation of Academic Research Ethics

## Education at I-Shou University

Ratified and promulgated by the President on December 31,  
2015

Amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by  
the President on May 22, 2017

- Article 1     The Regulations for the Implementation of Academic Research Ethics Education at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”) are made to educate master’s and PhD students (hereinafter referred to as “students”) on correct ethics perception and attitudes for academic research.
- Article 2     The academic research ethics education (hereinafter referred to as “the course”) is a required non-credit bearing course. Students admitted in or after Academic Year 2016 shall take the course on the website of the Center for Taiwan Academic Research Ethics Education.
- Article 3     Students shall pass an online exam on the Center’s website in order to apply for and download a certificate of study, and then submit the certificate to their department for review. The course will be registered as “Passed” after the review.
- Article 4     The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after being adopted by the University Administration Council and ratified by the President.

*Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as the interpretation of the language or terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.*
